Business analysis is performed on a variety of initiatives within an enterprise. Initiatives may be strategic, tactical, or operational.

- Complete a minimum of 7,500 hours of Business Analysis Work experience in the last 10 years.
- Within this experience, a minimum of 900 hours completed in 4 of the 6 BABOK® Guide Knowledge Areas, for a total of at least 3,600 of the required 7,500 total.
- Complete a minimum of 35 hours of Professional Development in the last 4 years.
- Provide two references.
- Agree to Code of Conduct.
- Agree to Terms and Conditions.
- Pass the exam.

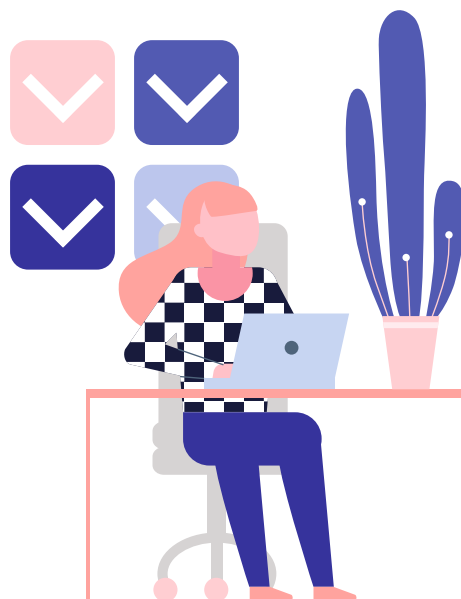

EXAM OVERVIEW

The CBAP® certification is achieved after appearing for the examination which is 3.5 hours long. The exam has 120 multiple choice questions.

The questions are case study-based (i.e., longer cases (1-1.5 pages) of information) with multiple questions about the case. The current exam blueprint based on v3.0 of the BABOK® Guide is as follows:

- Business Analysis Planning and Monitoring - 14%
- Elicitation and Collaboration - 12%
- Requirements Life Cycle Management - 15%
- Strategy Analysis - 15%
- Requirements Analysis and Design Definition - 30%
- Solution Evaluation - 14%
